## How to certify your **Transcript** of **Results**



Documents that are certified incorrectly will not be accepted, and this may cause a delay in your application to register. Follow the below instruction to correctly certify your Transcript of Results. You may wish to present this instruction to the person certifying your document.



Present the original document and a copy to a certifier who must be an independent person other than the applicant, such as a solicitor, An Garda Síochána, a Peace Commissioner, or a Commissioner for Oaths.




The certifier must confirm that the original transcript was produced to them by the transcript owner, that they have compared the copy with the original degree, and that they are satisfied that it is a true copy.



The copy must then be signed, dated and stamped by the certifier.



Certification is then written onto the copy by the certifier.
